SUBJECT: Public Notice – Updated Water Levels

Negative overnight temperatures have provided static water levels currently. However, Environment Canada is predicting a weather event for approximately a 33mm increase to take place over the next 48 hours. The Gull River Watershed will experience an extended period of high water levels and continues to remain in a flood warning.

The reservoir lakes and the Gull River will continue to remain at high levels as water moves from the upper areas of the watershed system.

Water levels on the Burnt River and Irondale River continue to decline

It is highly recommended that property owners, especially those who have a historical susceptibility to flooding, continue to monitor their situation for sandbagging requirements and self-evacuation of family and pets.
