SUBJECT: Public Notice – Flood Relief Registration

Under the Disaster Recover Assistance for Ontarians program (DRAO), the Province of Ontario **may** activate DRAO for damage to private property if there's a sudden, unexpected natural event, such as a flooding that causes costly and widespread damage in the area.

Residents, small businesses, farms, and not-for-profit organizations of Minden Hills are asked to **immediately** register their flooded property with the Recovery/Event Coordinator at 705-286-1260 ext. 211 or after hours at 1-866-856-3247.

Registering your property **does not** ensure financial assistance and is only being used, **at this time**, to determine the extent of damage as a result of flooding to permanent residents, small businesses, farms and not-for profit organizations.

To register your property, please be prepared with the following information:

- Name
- 911 Number (Street Address)
- Which structures are affected (i.e. main residence, garage, store, and other buildings)
- Contact Phone Number
